

**PEC Student Sets a New Record of highest marks in Qatar by Scoring 1010 marks in
FBISE SSC-II Annual Examination 2016.**

The students of Pakistan Education Centre (PEC) showed one of the best academic performances of the recent years in the result of the SSC-II annual examination 2016, declared by FBISE Islamabad today.

Eesha Naeem set a new record in the history of PEC by scoring 1010 marks out of 1050. **She got overall 1st position among all Pakistani schools in Doha** . Danial Hannan Babar stood 2nd by scoring 991 marks and Sana Saleem stood 3rd with 984 marks.
